- 1. All applications for the awards must reach the Secretary not later than 10 a.m. on the first morning of the show (usually the Saturday). Please inform the Show Manager when placing your entries that you will be submitting an application for a Floral Award. Applications must be made on this form.
- 2. Award categories are (a) Certificate of Preliminary Commendation, (b) Award of Merit and (c) First Class Certificate, all categories being awards for a daffodil cultivar for Exhibition.
- 3. Criteria for Awards:-
- (a) Certificate of Preliminary Commendation 3 stems. To be awarded to cultivars of great promise for exhibition. May be named and registered or a seedling.
- **(b) Award of Merit** 5 stems. Cultivar must be named and registered, is to be of great merit for exhibition and to have proved its worth as an exhibition flower. The cultivar must have been awarded at least two Premier Bloom Awards at National Shows. The flowers presented for the award should be of excellent showable standard.
- (c) First Class Certificate 10 stems. Cultivar must be named and registered, is to be of outstanding exhibition standard and to have proved its worth as an exhibition flower. The cultivar must have been awarded at least three Premier Bloom Awards at National Shows. The flowers presented for the award should be of excellent showable standard.
- 4. The cultivar presented must be raised in New Zealand.
- 5. Include below a short written précis of the cultivar's show record including Premier Bloom Award history for Awards of Merit and First Class Certificates.
